In the 2<sup>nd</sup> chapter of the Song of Solomon (the song of all songs) that means the very Best of Songs, the ultimate love song. We read in verse 10;

*Rise up, my love, my fair one and come away! And again in v) 13  
Rise up, my love, my fair one and come away!*

Beloved,  
He's calling you to Himself. Our Bridegroom (Yeshua Messiah - Jesus Christ) is coming back for His, Beloved, His Bride the Church. Our HOPE is sure and steadfast as we go behind the veil.

In Hebrews 6:19 it says;

*Our hope is certain. (Jesus made a way, we have victory in Jesus) It is something for the soul to hold on to. It is strong and secure. It goes all the way into the Most Holy place/Room behind the veil/curtain.*

After studying the word with 2 spellings, V.E.I.L. or V.A.I.L.; it is considered archaic **when VAIL is spelled with an A. It means a place of submission.** (He is the Ancient of Days!)



Spelling VEIL with an E it means:

- Secrecy
- Concealment - Hidden
- Protection
- Sacred screen
- Separation
- Covering

As we submit, surrender everything, not just part of us, but our ALL, we will be in that place of communion/right relationship with our Beloved behind the veil. The color Pink is for right relationships. We were created for fellowship.

Are you in right relationship with the LORD? Are you seeking Him? That miracle and healing for your soul is found in His presence. (The color turquoise is for healing) God's presence comes as we bow our hearts to Him.

- (Put veil on)

The scriptures speak of many different kinds of veils.

2 Corinthians 3 speaks about a veil that still remains on the hearts of those who are blinded and do not know the LORD. V) 16. Nevertheless when one turns to the LORD, the veil is taken away.

- (Take off veil)

V) 18. With unveiled faces we are being transformed into His image, and we have that HOPE, a surety that Jesus is coming back for us, His Bride.

Church as we go behind the veil (the realm of the Spirit) and submit our all to our King of Kings and Lord of Lords...the things of Earth will grow strangely dim as we delight in His glory & grace.
