Vision Interpretation

As I prayed over this vision, I sensed that the Lord is speaking directly to intercessors, especially women who have been faithful in hidden places. This is a call to those standing at the shoreline—between what has been and what is emerging. It is also an invitation to the wounded, the weary, and those who have stepped away from traditional structures but have not stepped away from God.

The empty seats and pre-service timing speak of a transition in how the Church gathers, heals, and encounters the LORD. The artisans reveal that creativity and craftsmanship are part of this healing movement.

Ultimately, this vision is for the Bride of Christ—being gently restored, prepared, and led by the Spirit into living waters where healing flows quietly and freely.
