

Moedim – God’s Sacred Days (March 31, 2020)

Scripture reference: Exodus 12 (Complete Jewish Bible)

Moed: #4150 Strongs (H) appointed time, place, or meeting

- Moedim= plural form of Moed

Appoint: #3259 Strongs (H) *root word*

Here are a few more definitions of Moed/Moedim: appointed feasts, appointed festival, appointed meeting place, sacred day, appointed sign, appointed time, appointment, assembly, a definite time, feasts, meeting place, seasons, gathering and a set time.

Beloved, we are in unprecedented times! The entire planet is being shaken, a cleansing is taking place. We are currently in an appointed time, a Feast of the LORD a Moed. But do we perceive it?

It is ADONAI’s Pesach [Passover]. Exodus 12:11b CJB

Passover is an appointed time set by the LORD (ADONAI). This Biblical Feast falls in the Hebrew month Nissan. As we observe Passover we are on a sacred journey into His Presence. This is a time of setting aside our distractions and meeting ADONAI at His appointed time. I don’t know about you but there is no place that I would rather be, amen?

3 Main Feasts of the LORD

FEAST	SEASON	REPRESENTS	PROVISION
PASSOVER	Spring	Outer Court	Redemption, Cleansing
PENTECOST	Late Spring	Holy Place	Maturity, His Word, His Spirit
TABERNACLES	Fall	Holy of Holies	Glory, a Dwelling Place

During Passover Moses was instructed by the LORD to speak to all of Israel and declare that Nissan is the first month of the New Year (Exodus 12:2). Reading a bit further to verse 7 it says;

They are to take some of the blood (from the lamb) and smear it on the two sides and top of the door-frame at the entrance of the house in which they eat it. Exodus 12:7

As many of you know my husband and I enjoy studying the scriptures from the Hebrew per-



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spective. I have 2 different images and 2 different Hebrew letters I’d like to share with you. I felt the LORD speak to my heart this morning before our ladies Bible Study on these 2 letters as well as the Feast of the LORD that we are currently in, Passover.

Page | 2 Here is an image from some flash cards that we have that shows the 5th letter of the Hebrew alphabet “H” Hey.




Figure 1: Hebrew letter "H" meanings

This Hebrew letter is representation of the month of Nissan. (Figure 1) God’s **breath** is blowing a fresh on His Bride. As she **looks** to Him He will bring **revelation** to her spirit. The Bride knows she can look to Him with full trust (faith) that He will protect, provide and sustain her during this current season. (Figure 2) The bottom left is a stick figure which is an ancient Hebrew pictograph of a person with raised arms.

So, what do we see? We see a person surrendering their will to ADONAI and giving full trust and praise to the One True God. The larger image in figure 2 is the 5th letter of the Hebrew alphabet. If we ready Exodus 12:7 again we can see that this letter was actually painted on the doorpost.

You’ve seen images of Biblical images on the Internet of the painting on the Blood on the

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Door posts right? Interesting isn’t it that these things all tie together? That’s God!! I would like to show you this Hebrew letter which is the 2nd letter of the alphabet “B” Beyt.

The beyt Hebrew letter is quite interesting, especially the ancient pictograph in figure 2. It is the 2nd letter of the alphabet and the pictograph is actually a tent floor plan. You can see the top there is an opening to enter in. The other symbol on the bottom of figure 2 is the primitive Paleo Greek symbol for the letter “B”.

The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14 (NIV)

The Word became a human being and lived with us, and we saw His Sh'khinah, the Sh'khinah (Shekinah Glory) of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth. John 1:14 (CJB)

DWELLING: #4637 Strongs (G) encamp, reside, occupy, pitch a tent and to tabernacle

As the Bride of Christ yields herself completely she becomes a tent, a dwelling place to house the Spirit of God. She is part of the family of God and His Shekinah will be revealed in her life as a sign to others that God is with her (Emmanuel=God with us). As she takes the Blood of The

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
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Lamb and places it over the doorpost of her tent, God will not allow the destroyer to come nigh her dwelling place. She will be passed over.

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For you have made ADONAI, the Most High, who is my refuge, your dwelling-place. No disaster will happen to you, no calamity will come near your tent; for He will order his angels to care for you and guard you wherever you go. Psalm 91:9-11



Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families, and slay the Passover [lamb]. "You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning. Exodus 12: 21-22

We are His Church, His Bride and as we apply the Blood of the Lamb (Yeshua the Messiah) over our lives His angels will keep watch over us. In verse 22 it says; take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood. Hyssop is symbolic of a cleansing purification from sin. We use hyssop essential oils today for the very same purpose; to cleanse the air with a diffuser and for healing of the physical body. David refers to hyssop in Psalm 51 as part of his repentant lament:

Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Psalm 51:7

Hyssop joins the **Biblical herbs and oils** as a purifier, whose name actually means **“holy herb.”** It was used in rituals, teas, wound healing, and baths in ancient times.

As we have spent a little time taking a look at a couple of Hebrew letters we can understand with a clearer perspective of what God is saying during our appointed time with Him this Passover. When we as the Bride apply the Blood of the Lamb, we are bringing cleansing, purification and deliverance into our lives.

Take courage Beloved, ADONAI is bringing deliverance from any plague that would come nigh to your dwelling place. The One True God is... King of the Universe!
Hallelujah to the Lamb of God! And so... we worship Him with hands lifted high! (Hey)



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
